

**CITY OF MELBOURNE  
RESOLUTION 20-02-01**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MAXIMUM PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS  
REQUESTED FOR FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2020 - JUNE 30, 2021**

**WHEREAS**, at the January 13th, 2020 regular city council meeting, the Melbourne City Council approved setting a public hearing for February 10th, 2020, on the maximum property tax dollars requested, and

**WHEREAS**, notice of said hearing was published as required in the Mid Iowa Enterprise and posted on the City website with a link on Melbourne Happenings Facebook page on January 23rd, 2020, and

**WHEREAS**, said hearing concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars was held on February 10th, 2020, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Melbourne has considered the proposed FY 2020/2021 maximum property tax dollars for the affected levy total, and


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Melbourne, Iowa, that the maximum property tax dollars for the affected tax levies for FY 2020/2021 shall not exceed the following total:

Total maximum levy for affected property tax levies – \$11.28278/\$1000 or \$223,055.  
The Maximum Property Tax dollars requested in the total maximum levy for affected property tax levies for the FY 2020/2021 represents an increase of greater than 102% from the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested for FY 2019/2020.
