A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MAXIMUM PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS REQUESTED FOR FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2020 - JUNE 30, 2021

WHEREAS, at the January 13th, 2020 regular city council meeting, the Melbourne City Council approved setting a public hearing for February 10th, 2020, on the maximum property tax dollars requested, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Melbourne, Iowa, that the maximum property tax dollars for the affected tax levies for FY 2020/2021 shall not exceed the following total:

Total maximum levy for affected property tax levies – \$11.28278/\$1000 or \$223,055. The Maximum Property Tax dollars requested in the total maximum levy for affected property tax levies for the FY 2020/2021 represents an increase of greater than 102% from the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested for FY 2019/2020.
