Explanation of significant increases in the budget:

There are increases of \$2310 in levies and decreases of \$3273 in levies, resulting in a net \$963 decrease or -.40%. The City is using a small fund balance to pay the remaining needed in FICA, IPERS & other benefits and allowing a small decrease. Insurance costs are increasing, but the levy is remaining the same and will be paid with fund balances or the general levy.
