Melbourne City Council met in regular session on April 21, 2025, at 7:00 pm at the Melbourne Library basement. Present were Council persons Gaege Bracy, Gary Fricke, Beth Smith and Beth Opperman. Also in attendance were Mayor Mansager and City Clerk Pothast. Meeting was called to order at 7 pm and Mansager led the Pledge of Allegiance. Hauser was not present. Resolution approved.

Hauser arrived shortly thereafter. Fricke again asked if PW would give a tour to Council this spring. He is particularly interested in the new workings at the pool. Clerk said they would be happy to. PW would like to wait until the pool is actually up and running to give the tour to see it in action. Mayor Mansager mentioned there is a taco truck that will be parked in front of Melbourne Pub again on Tuesday night from 4-7 pm for anyone interested in Taco Tuesday. There was miscellaneous discussion regarding trees and stump removal.
