Special City Council Meeting
June 2, 2026
5:00 at Library basement

Melbourne City Council met in regular session on June 2, 2026, at 5:00 pm at the Melbourne Library basement. Present were Council persons Beth Smith, Josh Fuller, and Gary Fricke. Also present were Mayor Cynthia Mansager and Clerk Mary Pothast. Mansager called the meeting to order at 5:00. Mansager led the Pledge. Motion to approve the agenda made by Smith, second by Fricke. Vote was all ayes.

In first business, a building permit for Clinton Dare at 201 Main Street for a back porch was presented. Council discussed the application and noted it is on the east side of the house, and not the west side as stated. Clerk corrected the document. Motion to approve by Fricke, second by Smith. Vote was all ayes to approve. Councilman Opperman arrived at 5:07.

Clerk presented the street repair bid from InRoads which had just been obtained. It was the exact map Fricke had given public works to use. Cost for the paving and pothole repairs is \$43,612.00. City had budgeted \$50,000 for 2026/27 fiscal year. Motion to approve by Fuller, 2nd by Opperman. Vote was all ayes. Tiffany Wade, Pool Manager, had inquired about getting a coffee truck to come to the parking lot during swim lessons. Council was agreeable. Fuller suggested she make sure there is no fee for them to attend, as that is often the case.

Motion to adjourn made by Opperman, 2nd by Smith. Vote was all ayes. Meeting adjourned at 5:25.
